First aid boxes are provided and restocked regularly as recommended by the HSA guidelines.(See Section 1 of Safety Statement) 4. First aid personnel are continuously available on the premises (day and night). 5. Records of first aid measures and treatments are retained. 6. Rooms for the provision of first aid are available, identified and adequately maintained. 7. First aid rooms are positioned close to external access route for emergency services. 8. Employees are aware of the names of first aiders on site. 9. Special provisions are made available as necessary i.e. safety showers, eyewashes etc. for personnel working with hazardous agents.
